

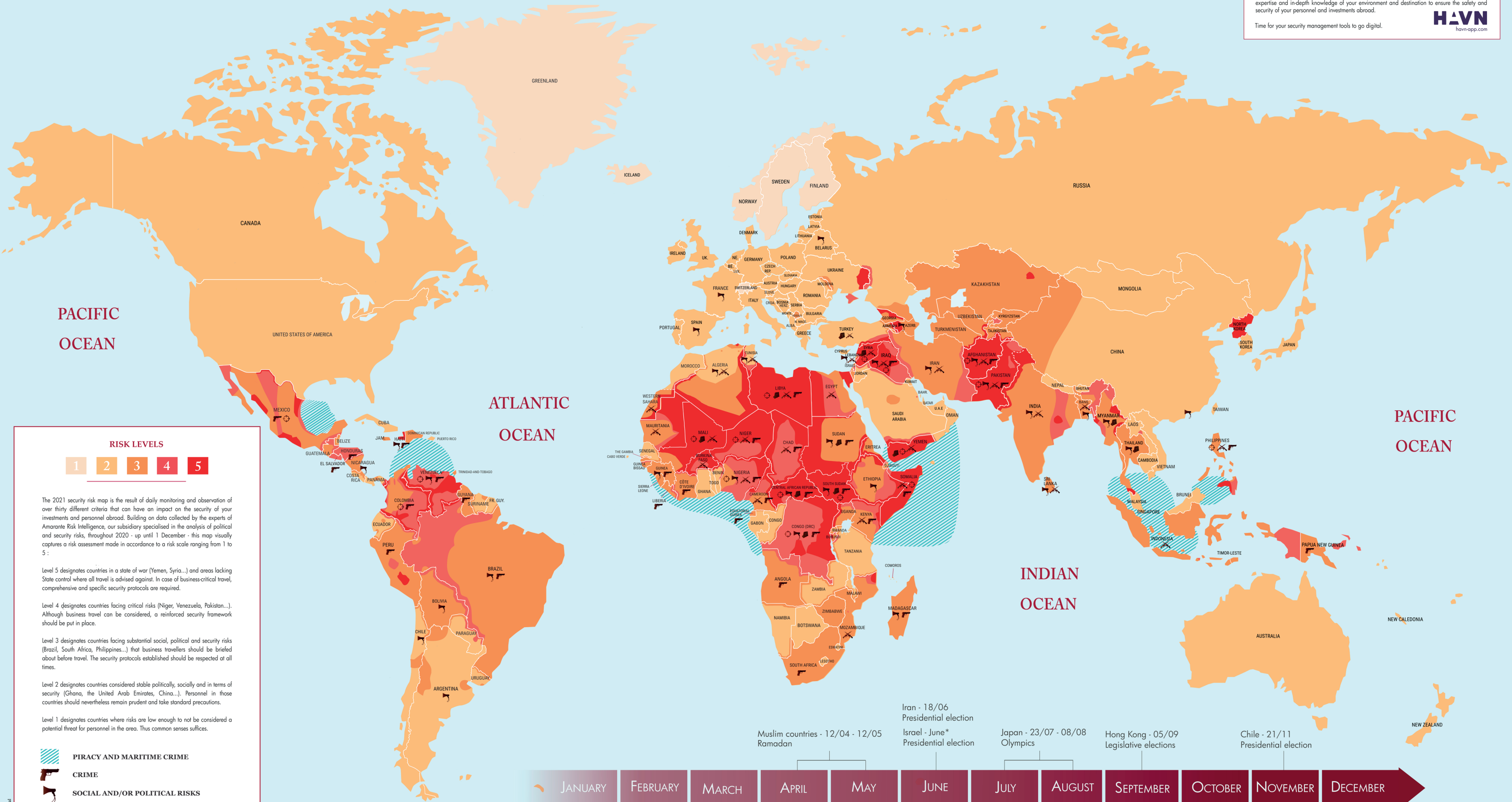

### RISK LEVELS



The 2021 security risk map is the result of daily monitoring and observation of over thirty different criteria that can have an impact on the security of your investments and personnel abroad. Building on data collected by the experts of Amarante Risk Intelligence, our subsidiary specialised in the analysis of political and security risks, throughout 2020 - up until 1 December - this map visually captures a risk assessment made in accordance to a risk scale ranging from 1 to 5 :

Level 5 designates countries in a state of war (Yemen, Syria...) and areas lacking State control where all travel is advised against. In case of business-critical travel, comprehensive and specific security protocols are required.

Level 4 designates countries facing critical risks (Niger, Venezuela, Pakistan...). Although business travel can be considered, a reinforced security framework should be put in place.

Level 3 designates countries facing substantial social, political and security risks (Brazil, South Africa, Philippines...) that business travellers should be briefed about before travel. The security protocols established should be respected at all times.

Level 2 designates countries considered stable politically, socially and in terms of security (Ghana, the United Arab Emirates, China...). Personnel in those countries should nevertheless remain prudent and take standard precautions.

Level 1 designates countries where risks are low enough to not be considered a potential threat for personnel in the area. Thus common senses suffices.
